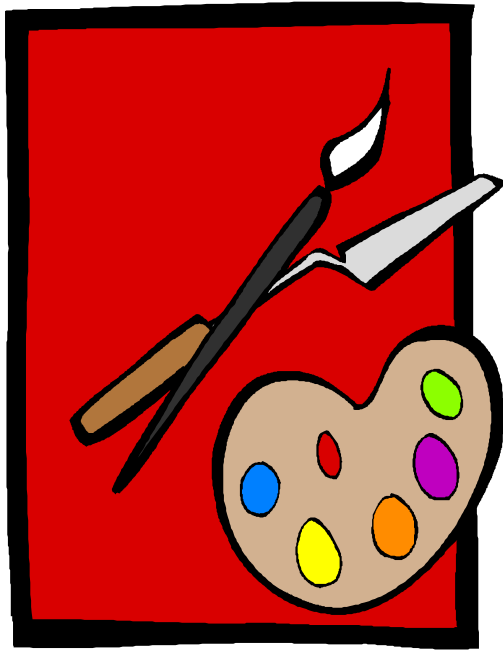

Participants are encouraged to bring their own reference materials and photos. The best paintings seem to evolve from scenes photographed by the artists themselves. A portion of each session will be devoted to critiquing. Participants are encouraged to bring a finished painting or a work in progress as this proves to be a valuable learning exercise for the whole group. 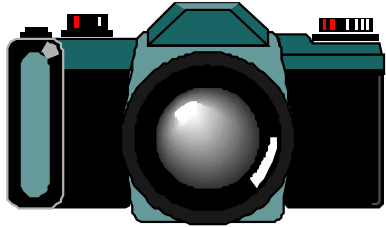

**Title:** FLAT CRYSTAL BRACELET - or - NECKLACE

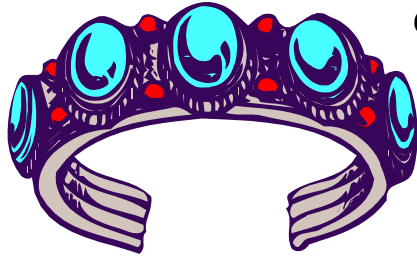
**Instructor:** Mary Ann Cernak

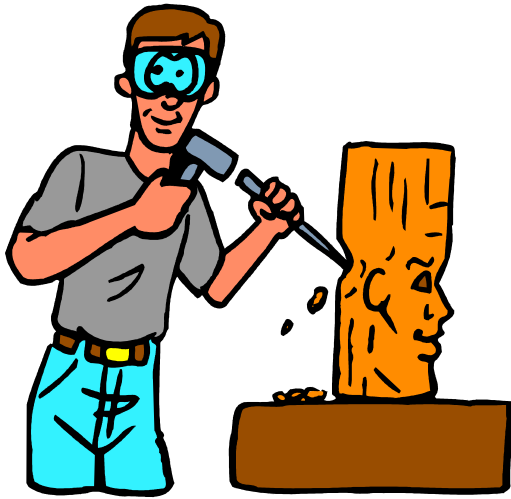
