### Clam Creek Bike Bath Closure - Monday, Mar 14

The bike path located at Clam Creek will be closed beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, March 14th in order for Glynn County to continue work on a mosquito control marsh enhancement project.

The marsh enhancement project will involve removing an existing culvert and portion of the bike path to restore the original tidal creek which will be spanned by a small bridge.

The bike path will be barricaded at the north and south entrance, but access will still be maintained towards Driftwood Beach and the beach access across Clam Creek Bridge at the Clam Creek Picnic Area. The bike path is scheduled to re-open to the public by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 18th.
