GSP June Report -

State Troopers from the Jekyll Island Post of the Georgia State Patrol investigated 7 traffic crashes during the month of June. SFC Chad Gray said the traffic crashes resulted in 1 injury and 0 traffic deaths. Jekyll Island Troopers responded to 21 calls during the month, which resulted in 5 criminal arrests.

SFC Gray said troopers from Post 35 issued 95 traffic / criminal citations on Jekyll Island and in the surrounding counties during the month. This total includes 3 arrest for driving under the influence, 58 citations for speeding, 9 seat belt violations, 2 child restraint violations and 167 warnings. Troopers also conducted 1038 business and residential checks on Jekyll Island during the month.

And that's the news from Jekyll Island where history lives, nature abounds, and be careful out there during this heat wave.
