### **Firewise Recognition Lunch Oct. 8**

The community of Jekyll Island has been recognized as a Firewise Communities/USA site by the national Firewise Communities program for its efforts to reduce the vulnerability of homes and landscapes to wildfire.

The award will be presented during National Fire Safety week at the EMS/Fire Headquarters on Stable Road on Thursday, October 8<sup>th</sup> at 1:00pm. Many fire and emergency responders, notably Public Safety Director Jason Richardson, will be in attendance.

The Jekyll Island Conservation Manager, as well as the Jekyll Island Garden Club has been invited in recognition of their sponsorship and support over the past three years to help achieve this goal.

C. Jones Hooks, Executive Director of Jekyll Island will accept the plaque on behalf of the community. The public is invited to share in the presentation of the award. The Jekyll Island Fire Department/EMS volunteers will provide barbecue and the United Way volunteers will be selling baked goods.

This will be a community event which will provide the opportunity for residents to gather information on what the Firewise program entails. Individuals may use this opportunity to register for a free Firewise Home Site Evaluation of their property and learn ways to incorporate Firewise recommendations on their own property to reduce the risk of damage by wildfire.
