Additional Census Workers Exams

Representatives of the U.S Dept. of Commerce will again be at the Convention Center Dec 22, at 2:00 pm and on Dec 30 at 6:00 pm taking applications and administering examinations for persons interested in part-time employment in connection with the 2010 U.S. Census. Workers will be hired in five different classifications at rates from \$13 - \$16 per hour.

As previously reported, the examination is a test of general knowledge and takes about 30 minutes. Applicants need to bring proof of identity such as a passport or drivers license plus one other form of identification. Veterans wishing to claim the hiring preference for which they are eligible must furnish proof of service such as Form DD214.
