#### JIA Notice on Power line Tree Trimming -

The JIA issued the following notice about the power line tree trimming being conducted around the island this month:

Georgia Power Tree Work Notice Issued February 12, 2018

Earlier this month, Georgia Power began routine maintenance on the primary power lines on Jekyll Island. When maintenance began, JIA staff had significant concerns about the aggressive trimming and issued a stop work order to Georgia Power. After meeting with Georgia Power, the company agreed to take a much more conservative approach to trimming as they continue their work on the island.

Please note, some trees that are growing directly under the power lines in the right of way, including smaller water and laurel oaks and palm trees, may need to be removed in select locations.

The JIA recognizes the importance of and supports Georgia Power's efforts to improve service to customers on Jekyll Island, and to minimize future power service outages. However, we will continue on-site visits and will closely monitor the trimming to ensure compliance with the JIA tree ordinance. As a reminder, the JIA tree ordinance remains in effect.

Please be aware that this work will continue through the month of February. Please use caution if you encounter tree work activity.
